What is the TBDBITL Alumni Mentoring Program?

A way for current students in the band and band alumni, on the same career path, to interact. A great networking opportunity

There are several types of interactions envisioned for this program, including but not limited to:

1. A regular commitment (daily, weekly or monthly) to be a mentor to a student in your field.
2. A one-time interaction with an individual student or a group where the typical workday is presented.
(An example could be a tour of your workplace facility).
3. An opportunity to talk to a student about internships, part-time and/or full-time employment at your companies.

Who can participate?

Any current student in the band and/or band alumni who are members in good standing with their respective band organization.


The purpose of the TBDBITL Alumni Mentoring Program is to provide an informal vehicle for interaction between Band alumni and current members of the Band who seek similar career paths, to assist the current band members in investigating, experiencing and selecting careers, As well as to provide a vehicle to refer, where appropriate, current members to advisors outside the program who possess necessary skills and expertise to assist the participant.

Members of the TBDBITL Alumni Club and members directly associated with the TBDBITL Alumni Mentoring Program will not be liable as monitors, guarantors or responsible parties with respect to interaction among the participants including contacts with and referrals to advisors outside the program, but rather will simply provide a vehicle for communication between interested students and interested alumni. 
Request as Mentor
